Who instructs webinars?

Where can I participate in JCAHPO Webinars?

Anywhere! As long as you have a computer with an internet connection, you can participate in JCAHPO and ATPO webinars anywhere in the world.

How often will new webinars be available?

The JCAHPO and ATPO webinar series will present a new topic each month.

Will this just be a power point presentation slide-show?

No. JCAHPO Webinars feature instructors who engage attendees with interactive content and cutting-edge technologies in eye care. At the end of each webinar, participants will have the opportunity to ask questions and review course content.

How do I get CE credit through webinars?
