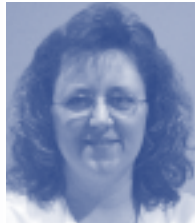
Karen Susco, BS, COMT, Lexington, Kentucky

We have an exciting Harold A. Stein Lecture planned. I am pleased to announce that William Lloyd, MD, FACS, University of California-

and a new tutorial will be available for candidate examination preparation. And with regard to JCAHPO certification opportunities, many of you may not know that JCAHPO now administers the Registered Ophthalmic Ultrasound Biometrist (ROUB) certification examination. We encourage any of you whose job responsibilities include biometry to look into this exciting certification as a means to increase, as well as recognize, your biometry skills.

The above items represent only a portion of the many new and exciting JCAHPO initiatives. It is important to mention, however, that all that JCAHPO is and does supports its mission to deliver high-quality patient care. I encourage you to get certified, certify at a new level, and to take advantage of JCAHPO's many classroom and distance learning opportunities.

More ATPO Review Sessions are Coming!

ATPO's COA, COT, and COMT Review Sessions have been very popular and well attended. All three levels of review sessions, including both the written and practical reviews, have been scheduled for Friday and/or Saturday, November 10th - 11th during the JCAHPO/ATPO Annual Meeting in Las Vegas. Below is a brief description of content.

During the COA Written Exam Review, the JCAHPO content areas 1-6 will be reviewed with participants in a classroom format. The attendee must possess a basic knowledge of eye anatomy and physiology with a minimum of one year in ophthalmology.

The COT Written Exam Review discusses JCAHPO content areas 7-13. The participant

must possess a good understanding of JCAHPO content areas 1-6 and a basic knowledge of content areas 7-13. The COT Practical Exam Review is designed to familiarize the participant with the computer-based skill simulation process currently utilized by JCAHPO. Participants should be familiar with performing the following skills in clinical practice: retinoscopy, refinement, ocular motility cover and alternate cover testing, keratometry, lensometry, tonometry, and visual fields. This is not an introductory workshop. The COT Skill Evaluation is being revised and a new tutorial will be available this summer for exam preparation.

The COMT Written Exam Review is designed to review JCAHPO content areas 1-23. The participant should possess a good understanding of content areas 1-13 and a basic knowledge of content areas 14-23. The COMT Practical Exam Review is designed to

review selected testing procedures and skills equivalent to the COMT level of certification. Areas covered will include: advanced tonometry, clinical optics I & II, ocular motility I & II, photography, special instruments and techniques (biometry), pupil assessment, and visual fields. These are not introductory courses and will not cover every procedure and skill equivalent to the COMT certification.

We are also planning to add more Review Sessions to the JCAHPO Regional CE program schedule. Be sure to watch the JCAHPO and ATPO Web sites for future dates and locations (www.jcahpo.org & www.atpo.org).

The COT and COMT Written Exam Review sessions are meant to provide a general review and are not designed to provide instruction. Also, the registrant must be at the appropriate level of certification for the review sessions (i.e. a COA cannot register for the COMT sessions).

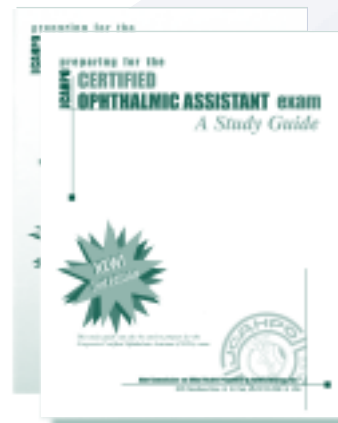

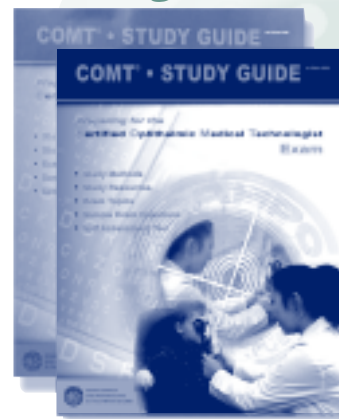
