## JCAHPO President's Message

This message will communicate information on significant initiatives and events that address the principle elements of JCAHPO's mission statement: certification and continuing education. I am pleased to bring you up-to-date on two very important issues: the job task analysis and its impact on JCAHPO's examination process, and the upcoming Annual Continuing Education (ACE) program in Las Vegas.

The Certification Committee completed and analyzed the results from its most recent Job Task Analysis (JTA) in 2005. The primary purpose for the JTA is to determine those tasks that are currently being performed by OMP at all three core JCAHPO certification levels, as well as surgical assisting. JTA data are then used to design and update certification examinations. The Committee is focused on updating the examinations over a period of two years, with new or revised COA and surgical assisting

examinations republished in August 2007, and the COT and COMT examinations republished in August 2008. The revised exams will also have a new look. Besides updating the content, test design will be improved with the addition of more graphics, visuals, and interactive exam items (questions). A new test blueprint, or test content, will be published in January 2007.

The ACE program promises to be a fun-filled, highly educational program this year. With more than 60 new courses, half-day sub-specialty courses, Masters-level Grand Rounds Case Presentations, and new coding & reimbursement courses offered, the program more than meets the needs for basic, intermediate, and advanced learners.

I am especially pleased that William Lloyd, MD, who will be speaking on the topic, "The Power of Mistakes", will present our Harold Stein Lecture. Dr. Lloyd is a highly

regarded speaker at JCAHPO's programs and elsewhere.

An exciting two-day product show will showcase new industry products. And, don't forget that for the first time this year, hotel rooms can be reserved directly with JCAHPO's hotel, The Riviera Hotel & Casino - be sure to take advantage of this opportunity! JCAHPO also offers scholarships to certificants who make application for assistance to attend the ACE program. See more information on available scholarships on page 7 of this issue of Viewpoints.

## COT Skill Evaluation to Offer Minus Cylinder Option

JCAHPO is pleased to announce that a new version of the Certified Ophthalmic Technician® Skill Evaluation will be launched in August 2006. This will include an option for the candidate to choose whether to complete a skill while working in plus (+) or minus (-) cylinder.

The Skill Evaluation is a computer-simulated assessment of a candidate's ability to perform seven critical ophthalmic tasks: applanation tonometry, automated visual fields, ocular motility, retinoscopy, refinement, manual lensometry, and keratometry. Three of these tasks - retinoscopy, refinement, and manual lensometry - involve optical measurements. Scenarios for these tasks were previously presented in plus (+) cylinder, and they have been redesigned to allow a candidate to work in minus (-) cylinder.

JCAHPO has also redesigned the COT Skill Evaluation Tutorial. The Tutorial is a CD-ROM that is mailed to the candidate when their application for the exam is completed. It helps to prepare the candidate for the actual exam by instructing them on the computerized controls and information that appear in the Skill Evaluation. The tutorial has been constructed to better accomplish this goal by providing more detailed information in a more succinct language and intuitive structure.

The JCAHPO COT Skill Evaluation cannot be taken until a candidate has passed the multiple-choice COT examination. More information concerning the Skill Evaluation can be found in the JCAHPO Criteria for Certification and Recertification Handbook. 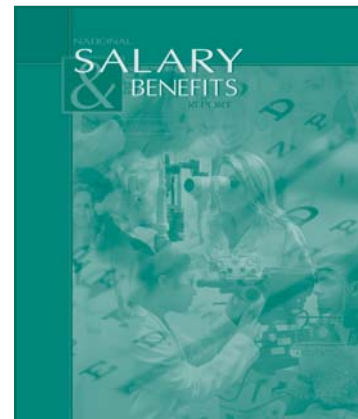

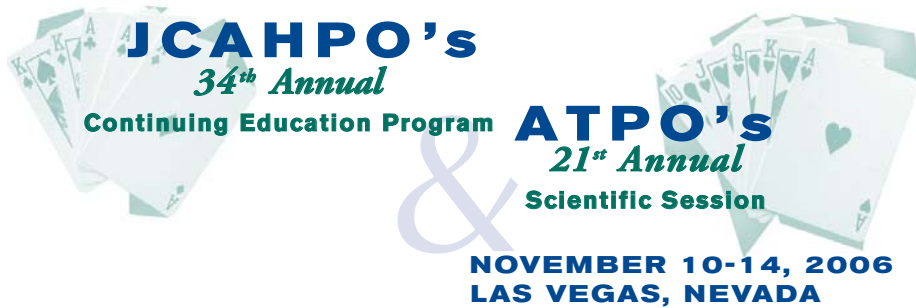
